Personal Statement: My interest as an artist of both bodily- and spatial polyphonies, focuses on the current interaction of still surviving polyphonic traditions and those yet to conceive. My work aims to use micro systems as a bridge between European *written*, and vocal Asian and African *orally transmitted* polyphonies. These pitch- rhythm- timbre- and spatial systems, a palette of fragmented tone colour pigments controlled in milliseconds, a sort of *musical Pointillism* in continuous movement, intends to provide a base for approximating any gestural-musical structure in a three- four- and multidimensional space by means of light–sound-path courses, directly from the substance-self of the live-performance.
